Influence and engage in complex natural resource initiatives

This position provides specialized expertise and leadership in the field of visual resource management of Crown land, including implementation of legislation, policies and procedures for the protection and enhancement of visual and scenic values for public recreational enjoyment, Indigenous peoples' values, and the tourism sector. This role promotes a balanced approach to forest management and other industrial activities on BC's visually sensitive landscape.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Master's degree or higher in forestry or related resource management field with an emphasis on visual resource management AND a minimum of 2 years of forestry related experience, OR
- A Bachelor's degree in forestry or related resource management field with an emphasis on visual resource management AND a minimum of 3 years of forestry related experience, OR
- A diploma in forestry or a related field and a minimum of 5 years of forestry-related experience, OR
- An equivalent combination of education, training and experience may be considered.
- Must be registered or immediately* eligible for registration either as a Registered Professional Forrester (R.P.F.) with the Association of BC Forest Professionals ([ABC FP](#)) or as a Professional Agrologist (P.Ag.) with the BC Institute of Agrologists ([BCIA](#)), or as a Professional Engineer (P. Eng.) with the Association of BC Professional Engineers and Geoscientists ([EGBC](#)). Preference may be given to applicants who are registered as an RPF with the ABCFP.
- Demonstrated experience in visual resource management concepts, principles and practices.
