The GIS Coordinator will work to promote cooperation between the business areas, build collaboration to achieve business efficiencies and coordinate efforts with other BCTS GIS teams.

The purpose of this position is to also develop and implement GIS Technology Entry Level Program (GTELP) for the Northern and Provincial needs. GTELP will address ongoing training and effective knowledge transfer needs for BCTS GIS, and maximize the potential of GIS and related geospatial and information technologies to support the business objectives of the program and its clients.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Diploma or degree in geographic information systems, natural resources management, geography, computer science or a related field and a minimum of five years recent related experience; OR the equivalent combination of training and experience may also be considered.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience developing and managing large spatial and attribute data sets and experience with database management tools and applications.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience developing methodologies, and performing custom geospatial data modelling and complex analysis and interpretations.
- Demonstrated project management/administration experience.
